We are going to be running a cake stall after school **today** to raise money for the earthquake victims in Nepal, cakes will be sold in school and by the War Memorial in the village, we hope lots of parents and villagers buy cake so we can raise lots of money for the International Nepal Fellowship who are currently in Nepal helping the Earthquake victims. We will let you know next week how much we manage to raise.

Having lived in Nepal for several years, Miss Moss (one of our Branscombe teachers) has advised us on how best to get this money to those in need:

"INF (the International Nepal Fellowship) is a Christian medical mission working in health and development among some of the poorest people of Nepal. I worked for them for six years between 2000 and 2006 teaching the children of expatriate personnel. This week I have been in touch with friends and former colleagues who have been updating me on the current situation. Being in place within Nepal, INF were in a good position to respond immediately in distributing aid and relief following last weekend's devastating earthquake. They have already sent a medical team to the region at the epicentre of the earthquake (Gorkha) though they quickly ascertained that the primary need is for relief such as food, water and shelter. They are now loading trucks from their base in Pokhara to send food, tents and other essential items to those worst affected. You can find out more on their website (www.inf.org)."






OVER THE HILL & FARWAY 10K RUN SUNDAY 21 JUNE 2015




10AM START AT FARWAY VILLAGE HALL, EX24 6DQ
